Research Background

- Research in the dermatology department focuses on the pathogenesis of various skin conditions and research for new treatments. Specific research includes:
- The use of antibiotics in dogs with pyoderma and otitis externa in the light of increased antibiotic resistance
- The pathogenesis and management of canine otitis externa
- Wound healing

Research Capabilities

- At the veterinary hospital, veterinary dermatology research is carried out in two major areas –
- Clinical research to gain greater understanding of animal skin disorders
- Phase III clinical trials for companies developing veterinary diagnostics and medications
- The hospital has permission to work with and provides access to laboratory animals.
